- Job 602 Church Street paving
- Job 603 Church Street misc.
- Job 604 Various paving
- Job 605 Various 3" berm
- Job 606 Various Sweeping

to the full extent indicate on the Preliminary Road Program.

2. The County shall be compensated as set forth in the Village of Beaverdam 2016 Preliminary Road Program.

To: Village Mayors, Councilmen, Clerks and Administrators

RE: 2016 Village Road Work Being Done in Cooperation with the Allen County Engineer

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed a copy of a preliminary road program estimate for the road work for your village to be performed by Allen County road crews this summer. Also find enclosed an explanation sheet that explains what each column on the road program estimate represents. I ask that you review the enclosed road program estimate and contact this office if there are any corrections to be made. If the estimate is satisfactory, I ask that you send a copy of a resolution or ordinance from your village council authorizing the Allen County Engineer's forces to proceed with the roadwork shown on the road program estimate. We need to have your road program finalized and turned into this office by **April 19st**. If your village council doesn't meet again until after that date, or if you have further changes in your program, just let us know by **April 19st** which projects you intend to do this year, and then approve the revised road program estimate at your next regularly scheduled meeting. If you have any CONTRACT PAVING being done as part of the county's paving contract, we will be in touch with you in early May about passing an ordinance authorizing the county to advertise for bids in June.

The actual costs (labor and materials) of your road program projects will be invoiced to your village when they are completed this summer. If you are applying for **\$5 Permissive Tax Monies** for some of your road projects, you need to have the necessary paperwork filed and approved by the Allen County Commissioners and this office. The correct procedure for the disbursement of \$5 permissive tax monies is clearly spelled out in Section 4504.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. I have enclosed a copy of a checklist that must be followed by village/city clerks and administrators, in order to receive \$5 permissive tax funds. If you have any questions regarding the checklist and the correct procedures, please feel free to contact Laura Clark at this office, who is the administrator of the funds. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Also, if you have streets that you wish to have **centerline striped** by our crew please contact Bruce Fricke by **April 19st** to get those streets scheduled to be striped.

A final road program meeting of all Villages, Township Trustees, Clerks, County Engineer and County Commissioners will be held on **Tuesday, April 19, 2016, at 11:00 A.M.** at the County Engineer's Office. **Lunch will be served around 11:40 A.M. Please plan to attend.**
