**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVERDAM ESTABLISHING
THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS LIST FOR 2017
AND ESTABLISHING THE RATE FOR THE IMPACT FEE**

WHEREAS, the Village has adopted an Impact Fee Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the Impact Fee Ordinance, as it presently exists, or as it may be amended, requires the Village Council to annually adopt a Capital Improvements List and Impact Fee Calculation.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Village of Beaverdam, that the following Capital Improvements are deemed to be necessary to provide for the health safety and welfare of the Village residents, and to provide necessary services to new development projects:

1. Expand lagoons
2. Extend Interstate 75 waterways - North and South
3. Increase pump capacity at the water treatment plant
4. Install street lights in areas of businesses
5. Loop Eastside of Interstate 75 properties with water main
6. Scada system for water and waste water systems

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Impact Fee, as established by the Village ordinances, shall be calculated as follows:

The average estimated daily water usage in gallons shall be determined, as provided by the Impact Fee Ordinance, or as otherwise authorized by the Village Council. This figure shall then be multiplied by Twenty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$25.00) per gallon. The result shall be the Impact Fee due and owing in relation to the contemplated new development project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Impact Fee, as established above, shall be retroactive and deemed to apply since the last resolution establishing the impact fee.
