ALLEN COUNTY, OHIO PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL HOLIDAY BONUSES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-35

PASSED: NOVEMBER 21, 2015

WHEREAS, the Village has a long standing policy of recognizing the efforts of its employees;

AND, WHEREAS, it is a direct benefit to the Village to retain qualified employees who perform above average service to the Village.


AND, WHEREAS, the Village desires to recognize the efforts of its employees at the end of the year and during the holiday season.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Beaverdam, a majority of its members herein concurring,

1. We wish to recognize the diligence and exceptional effort exhibited by our employees throughout the year.
2. We wish to recognize the employees frequently going above and beyond their duties for the benefit of the Village and its inhabitants, in responding to storms and other emergencies.
3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency so that the bonus may be provided in the same fiscal year the services were provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, in recognition of the above, each of the Village employees, Tim Neuenschwander, Trent Long, Annie Mae Palte and Michael Leis shall receive a \$125.00 gift card in recognition of their efforts and Tyler Thompson a \$35.00 gift card.
