DECEMBER 1, 2020**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVERDAM, OHIO, ESTABLISHING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS LIST FOR 2021 AND ESTABLISHING THE RATE FOR THE IMPACT FEE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Beaverdam has adopted an Impact Fee Ordinance (1998-11); and

WHEREAS, the Impact Fee Ordinance, as it presently exists, or as it may be amended, requires the Village Council to annually adopt a Capital Improvements List and Impact Fee Calculation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Village of Beaverdam, that the following Capital Improvements are deemed to be necessary to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the Village residents, and to provide necessary services to new development projects:

1. Preventative Maintenance at Village Lagoons
2. Upgrade Street Lighting
3. Loop Eastside of Interstate 75 properties with Water Main
4. Upgrade Scada System for water and waste water systems
5. Upgrade water meter system


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Impact Fee, as established by the Village ordinances, shall be calculated as follows:

The average estimated daily water usage in gallons shall be determined, as provided by the Impact Fee Ordinance, or as otherwise authorized by the Village Council. This figure shall then be multiplied by Forty and 00/100 Dollars (\$40.00) per gallon. The result shall be the Impact Fee due and owing in relation to the contemplated new development project.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Impact Fee, as established above, shall be effective at the earliest time provided for by law.
