AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVERDAM, ALLEN COUNTY, OHIO, MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 2020-18 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE, REALLOCATING MONIES WITHIN A FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

An Ordinance to make supplemental appropriations and to amend appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures of the Village of Beaverdam, Allen County, Ohio, during the year ending December 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, The Village of Beaverdam Council adopted Ordinance 2020-18; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Beaverdam Council deems it necessary to amend Ordinance 2020-18.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVERDAM, ALLEN COUNTY, OHIO.

Section 1: That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Beaverdam during the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2020, the following sums be and are hereby set aside and appropriated in addition to those in Ordinance 2020-18 as follows:


