**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS TO PURCHASE A NEW DUMP/PLOW TRUCK AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village is in need of a new Dump /Plow Truck

**AND WHEREAS**, it is necessary to advertise and purchase a new Dump/Plow Truck as soon as possible to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVERDAM, AT LEAST TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING THAT:**

1. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 721.03, the Village Fiscal Officer shall cause notice of intent to purchase and a solicitation for bids to be published once per week for five (5) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Allen County, Ohio.
2. A purchase agreement contract, in writing shall then be entered with the lowest bidder, at the discretion of Council.
3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to execute such documents and incur such debt as may be reasonable and necessary to secure the publication.
4. The Mayor is authorized to execute a written lease with the successful bidder, upon approval of the Village Council.


